Definitive registration: October 15, 2017

Insurance: All participating Delegations should have their own health and accident insurance as the organizer will not be responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents and illness.

Judges: Judges with International IFAGG level. Judges proposal (on IFAGG registration form) must be made to IFAGG via e-mail: judges@ifagg.com by October 15th, 2017.

Accreditation: Delegations accreditation will take a place upon arrival. Heads of Delegations must check the correct names of their complete Delegation, bring the passports of all gymnasts, proof of medical insurance of all members, make any necessary payments, CD with music for the program (2 copies), a CD with the national anthem and national flag for awarding ceremony. The accreditation will be held in the competition office.

Visa: Please verify immediately with your travel agent or United State embassy or Consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Chicago, US. The organizer will be happy to assist each Delegation with an official invitation letter. The request must include full name, function, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates, as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.

Accommodation and meals

Hotel: [Aloft Hotel, Bolingbrook, Illinois](#)

100 EUR Single room (one king bed – 190 cm wide), including breakfast

110 EUR Single room (one king bed), room for 2 persons (sharing a bed), including breakfast

120 EUR Double room (2 queen beds- 150 cm wide): room for 2 persons, including breakfast

130 EUR Double room (2 queen beds); room for 3 or 4 persons (sharing a bed), including breakfast

Breakfast: bagel or muffin, yogurt, fruit (banana, orange, apple) and water bottle.

Lunch 10 EUR & Dinner 10 EUR / person/day – will be provided in competition hall.
Stefan Grill Restaurant: Traditional Balkan cuisine, everything is homemade (chicken soup, grilled chicken breast with oven roasted potato, tilapia fish, oven roasted turkey breast with gravy sauce and mashed potato, pasta, lasagna, turkey club, beef links stuffed in homemade bread, etc.)

Parking – free

Shuttle busses between hotel and competition hall: 10 EUR /person

IMPORTANT: Accommodation, meals and shuttle must be booked only in the official hotel through the organization.

Accommodation Reservation form must be turned by September 1st, 2017 at the very latest. The Hotel rooms will be allocated on a “first come, first serve” basis.

Accommodation will be paid by invoice from the organizer.

All other hotel expenses or extra charges (telephone, cafeteria,..) must be paid directly to the hotel.
